




Hereinafter jointly referred to as "Trustees" (which expression shall, unless excluded or repugnant to the context, be deemed to include the Trustee or trustees for the time being of these presents and their successors in office) of the other part.

And whereas if the Trustees desire to co- opt another eminent personalities as trustees for betterment of trust, they can co-opt.

And whereas if any vacancy made in Board of trustees these vacancy can be fulfilled by Co- option. Whereas the Settler is desirous of establishing a trust for public charitable objects.

And whereas the Trustees have, at the request of the settler, agreed to act as the first trustees of these presents as testified their being parties to and executing these presents.

And whereas it is necessary to declare the aims and objects of the public charitable public Trust, being constituted under these presents.

Now this indenture witnesseth as follows:-

1. That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 51,000 Fifty one Thousand (hereinafter called the Trust Fund which expression shall include cash and any other property of investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted invested or varied from time to

time which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents) , and the trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers , provisions , agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

That the name of the trust shall HODA WELFARE FOUNDATION and office will be situated 32, Patliputra Colony, P.O + P.S- Patliputra Colony, Patna-800013, Bihar. (INDIA) And / or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide from time to time.

- 2. That the objects for which this trust is established are:
- 1. To create a sense of brotherhood, co-operation, mutual harmony, love and affection amongst the member of the Trust and also amongst the general public.
- 2. To start, establish, run take over or manage and maintain the school, with the object to provide sound nursery, pre- primary, Middle, secondary, senior secondary schools and higher education to children/students by seeking recognition and affiliation from the education departments etc.
- 3. To establish, run maintain and grant aid in cash or kinds to advance technical education, colleges including engineering & Diploma Colleges, Medical college, Management Education Institute, Computer Science & Engineering Institutes & specialized studies & research institutes to provide standard and high class education for B.Ed, B.E./B. Tech/B. Arc/MBA, B.B.A, Bsc IT, B.C.A, Nursing, Nutrition, Dietetics, yoga fitness, Non formal education, Hospitality Management, Computer Literacy Paramedical, courses and other related courses to the students according to rules and regulations of UGC, All India council for technical education, National council for vocational Training, National council for Teacher's Education, Nursing council of India & state government.
- 4. To organize camps, training, seminar, press conference, exhibition, Nukadd Natak and other programme on disaster management and other related problems.
- 5. To provide information and education/useful knowledge and the medical advice, to general public regarding the vices of the society like smack, smoking (cigarette/biri/hukka), use of alcohol/wine, HIV-AIDS, Polio Drop, Chicken pocks etc. Through holding awareness camps for de –addiction and also organize the lecture by expert team of Doctors, Journalists, Lawyers, professionals and other learned persons.

- 6. To open, found, establish, promote, setup, run, maintain, assist, finance, support and/or help the various community development programs/ activities and also construct and develop the, pio, Dharamshala, Night Shelters, Old Age Homes, Orphanage, Health Care Centers, Crèche (Day Care Centers), Diet & Fitness Centre, Dietetic Internship Center, Charitable Dispensaries, Hospitals, Shochalay, Libraries, Reading Room, Play Grounds, Yoga & Health Centers, Meditation centres, Research centres, Gymnasiums, Sangeetaly & Nrityalay (music and dance training center), Anganwari, Balwari , Mahila Ashram, Studios, Drama, Stage and other buildings/institutions for use of General Public and for welfare of the general public.
- 7. To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment or maintenance of wells, tube-wells, tanks, water reservoirs, trees and also to make the construction & maintenance of paths, Roads, khadanja, Bridges, Parks, Sewerage, Sanitation, washing & dry cleaning and other buildings and institutions which are used by the general public.
- 8. To take up effective but reasonable and lawful steps for the eradication of social evils such as Dowry System, Child Marriage (BalVivah), Child Labor, Wastage of money in the various function and use of intoxicated drugs/wine/smack etc.
- 9. To help the street children by providing them shelter, food and education.
- 10. To help poor and indigent persons in marriages of their sons and daughters by way of cash donation or otherwise and to distribute clothes, food and other necessaries of daily life amongst the poor, orphan and indigent persons.
- 11. To take up effective, reasonable and lawful steps for the solution of the problems relating to the blind, handicapped, mentally handicapped, deaf, dumb and other disabled through the various kinds of training programs and also providing them required facilities to make them independent.
- 12. To give provide and/or render monetary and/or other help and assistance for the relief of persons and animals affected by natural and other calamities such as flood, fire, famine, cyclone, earth quake, storm, accident, pestilence, drought, epidemic, unbearable cost of living and the like, too give donations, subscriptions or contributions to institutions, establishment, centers or persons doing relief work on such occasion.
- 13. To provide food, cloths, shelter (temporary/permanent), medicines and other required facilities to the people who have faced the Natural Calamity and/or the disaster.

- 14. To make best efforts for protection, promotion and for the advancement of women, children, old aged, handicapped, orphans, widows, destitute and mentally retarded persons.
- 15. To create a forum for senior citizens where they can exchange their various views and experiences which may be make available to younger generation,
- 16. To follow the ideology of great men and national leaders who sacrificed their lives for our Nation & humanity.
- 17. To start various programs against child labour and take up effective but reasonable and lawful steps on this connection for the welfare of children.
- 18. To educate the people and organize various kinds of awareness programmes/activities regarding consumer protection Laws and rights of the public in this connection.
- 19. To work for promotion and diffusion of useful knowledge and advancement of Indian art, culture and philosophy.
- To award appropriate certificates or diplomas in respect of educational, vocational or technical training courses administered and carried out by the Trust.
- 21. To promote fine art, crafts among the public including establishment and maintenance of shilp-shikshalay, Beauty Parlour, Boutique, fashion house, Etc.
- 22. To offer prizes and grant scholarship to deserving students and also to provide all possible facilities to the students who are interested to go abroad for higher education.
- 23. To arrange and organize exhibitions, training and research programs on the subjects/matters relating to the villagers and people belongs to the rural areas and tribal areas of the India and also start different integrated village development' programs in all over India
- 24. To approach the farmers (and the people connected with agriculture) and provide them the latest technology and the research information in the fields of agriculture for the betterment of farmers/agriculturists.
- 25. To start, run and manage the various training centres like poultry, piggery, fishery, Cottage industries, Bee-keeping, Dairy industries, Foods & fruits preservation, etc. to train the young boys and girls belonging to the economically weaker section and also for the solution of the problems of unemployment and also provide all necessary facilities to the trainees.

- 26. To establish and maintain institutions for the handicapped, blind, deaf, dumb, poor, SC, ST, minorities, backward classes and other needy people to provide the training of house hold industries, semi- skilled jobs and also to provide them other required facilities like hostels, medical aid, food, cloths, transportation and economic assistance to start new business.
- 27. To open, found, establish, promote, setup, run maintain, assist, finance, support and/or aid or help in the setting up and/or running hospitals, charitable dispensaries, mobile dispensaries, maternity homes, child welfare centres, convalescent homes, sanatorium, hostels and other similar institutions or centres for rendering or providing medical relief.
- 28. To open centres/institutes for diagnostic curative and research of cancer, AIDS, T.B. and other deadly diseases.
- 29. To arrange and organize Eye and Blood donation camps.
- 30. To make best efforts and organize various kinds of programs and/or activities relating to Family planning and to diffuse the useful knowledge about the medicines, equipment's, methods used for family planning also provide the family counselling facilities.
- 31. To make best efforts to provide security, shelter, respect, employment and other required/necessary facilities to the Drunkers, prostitutes and their dependent children.
- 32. To make arrangement for mobile emergency van/ambulance for the victims of road accident, to provide help to pregnant ladies to shift them to nearby hospital, also to provide assistance to the old people for the emergency.
- 33. To provide nursing aid to the needy people especially for the old age men and women, orphan, ill etc.
- 34. To promote the interest of people in environment, sense of integration, self-employment, family planning, sanitation, proper food intake behaviour, Healthy life style, etc. by making Audio Visual, Tele Films, TV serials & documentaries.
- 35. To conduct training and research programs for Pollution control (in water, air, soil, earth, atmosphere), polluted diseases and to maintain/develop and also protect the herb's, forests, environment, species of the animals, birds, wild life and other natural gifts helping to so support the preservation of environment.
- 36. To bring under productive use of the wasteland through a massive programs of forestation and tree plantation.
- 37. To educate and provide training to the students, candidates, general public about rapidly increasing harmful environmental purely, preparation for plantation of trees and plants and to organize

camps, seminars, films shows for environmental protection and to establish environment preservation and pollution control centres to restrain the spread pollution.

- 38. To do generally all such other acts, deeds, things and activities, which are fit and proper for pollution control and protection of environment, forest and wild life.
- 39. To encourage games, sports, yoga, judo, Karate, Boxing, hockey, football, cricket and other national and international games/sports for improvement of health amongst the youth and children on the whole and organize tournaments, yoga & sports competitions on block, district level.
- 40. To collect information, notices, notifications, policies from the government, semi government, national/international agencies and N. G. Os. And also provide the same to members of society and general public.
- 41. To organize seminars, meetings, press- conferences and other lawful gatherings from time to time.
- 42. To provide legal medical aid, social economic help and assistance to the needy people.
- 43. To approach to the competent court/courts to safeguard the right of the general public and for the public interests from time to time as the society may deem fit and proper.
- 44. To open, found establish, promote, setup, run, maintain, assist, support and/or aid and help in setting up the different kinds of colleges and research institutions for advancement of technical education and in all their manifestations.
- 45. To run management institutes/ professional courses in the field of finance including international finance, business management, commerce, computer application and allied subjects/activities.
- 46. To start various kinds of skill development training courses like-teachers training, nurses training, laboratory assistant, hospital, education centre cum clinics, maternity homes, child care centre and such other institutions (after getting the permission and/or affiliation from the competent authority (s), if it is required) for the solution of problem of un-employment, amongst the young generation.
- 47. To establish, run, maintain, manage and control the various school/colleges/training institutions/courses like: medical, dental, paramedical, Ayurvedic, homeopathic, naturopathy, pharmacy, nursing, laboratory, occupational therapy, public health and nutrition, beautician, acupuncture and acupressure therapy, Reki,

- 48. To promote & marketing Ayurvedic medicine, Health Camp, Yoga Camp, Seminar, workshop& Training.
- 49. To initiate handicraft Sector, cottage industries or any other schemes and conduct skill training which provide employment to poor people in rural and urban area, with the help of concerned authorities.
- 50. To maintain small industries organizations, cooperative Societies, firms, to run STD's Phone Booths, Petrol pumps other commercial units and utilizes the profit for the welfare of the poor people of the country.
- 51. To spread appropriate technology among the people agriculture, dairy farming poultry terming, libraries, dispensaries, school, hospital, institution for the welfare of society.
- 52. To undertake , develop , manage , arrange or organise antique show, art show, audio and video show , fashion show , magic show , the magic puppet show, charity premier show , car rally , dance events, fancy dress competition, fete greeting card and handicraft exhibition film shows foundation or endowment of award and prizes.
- 53. To acquire , hold , transfer , mortgage , lease out and dispose of and otherwise deal with property of the Trust in any manner whatsoever and get loan for the fulfilment of objective of the Trust.
- 54. To undertake , carryout , promote, sponsor , discharge, full fill , participate , collaborate, manage or organise the programmes with peoples co-operation , national and international Government and Non- Government agencies and to carry-out all necessary acts for the achievement of the objectives .
- 55. To accept loan, Grant-in Aid, donation (either in cash or kind), subsidy or other assistance lawfully, either from national and / or International agencies for the attainment of the objective of the Trust.
- 56. To undertake, organise, investigate, participate, sponsor, the human right programmes including awakening of human right, preservation of fundamental rights, protection & safeguards to the victims of human right violations, for the freedom, dignity and peace of the people. Also undertake study, research, publications, treaties with national and international institutions and award programmes, for the effective implementation of Human Rights.

- 58. To promote income generation activities among general people in rural/urban areas.
- 59. To publish study materials, magazine, books, training modules, information material, journals and to produce film, TV serials, documentaries and audio- video cassettes on social, educational, scientific health and nutrition issues.
- 60. To promote, develop, modernisation of food processing industries, quality assurance and market survey.
- 61. To organise, establish, run and maintain awareness camp, counselling centre, health centre, awareness programme, short term courses to avoid and treat the disease and complication related to wrong life style and poor dietary habits.
- 62. To organise activities for development of physically handicapped and to provide medical facility for the needy and poor, where medical services are inadequate to meet the demand.
- 63. To conduct various safe mother and child survival, family welfare, Control of female foeticides and population education programmes.
- 64. To organise, formal, non-formal, adult education, various sanitation programme for upliftment of better sanitation, eco-friendly environment and promotion of general health condition of people and to organise different training activities for the grass root level worker to raise their efficiency and skill.
- 65. To provide micro credit consulting and undertake impact evaluation for funding agencies and banks.
- 66. To promote the alternative sources of energy like bio-gas, solar through the environmental programme.
- 67. To promote mahila mandals, self help groups, youth groups, women empowerment for the development of women, youth and children.
- 68. To undertake prefeasibility studies for in the areas related to governance, consultancy, project monitoring, internal system design an implementation, taxation, internal audit, reporting on implementation of project, strategic planning, interim management, evaluation, financial planning development consulting, capacity building for micro enterprises and organisation development.

- 69. To undertake other activities like field action project research, advocacy, networking and to promote understanding and better professional practice in the areas of social work, social services and allied professional fields.
- 70. To bring about effective integration of community participation in various development schemes lunched by the government and other social development organisations.
- 71. To offer management consultancy and implementation & support services to various state, central government organisation.
- 72. To work for the promotion of folk culture, music, and other arts of different areas and protect them from vanishing by organising functions and encouraging artists.

All the activities shall be Non-Profitable and shall be done on No Profit - No Loss basis.

- All the incomes, earnings, movable / immovable properties of the Trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its Aims and objects only as set forth in the deed of the Trust and no profit there of shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or the past member of the Trust or to any person claiming through any one more of the present or the past members. No members of the Trust shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the Trust or make any profits, whatsoever, by virtue of his membership.
- 5. That the Trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund also by donations and other contribution from time to time.
- 6. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in Para 3 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.
- 7. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the Trust.
- 8. Subject to the provisions of Income Tax Act. 1961 as amended from time to time, the Trustees will keep the Trust Fund of such portion thereof, as they may, in their absolute discretion, think fit and proper, without being answerable or accountable to the beneficiaries or any other party for any loss invested in such shares, stock, securities and debentures of acquisition or construction of any immovable property including building and /or in the purchase and acquisition or mortgage by way of fresh charge on any immovable property in India, of free-hold or lease-

hold tenure, and may deposit the amounts with any scheduled Bank, Company or Private firm any Individual on such terms and conditions as they think fit, in the matter of investment of Trust funds, the provisions of section 20 of the Indian Trust Act shall apply, in the event of Trustees purchasing any immovable property or properties or advancing moneys or mortgage, they shall be entitled to accept such title or evidence of title as they shall think fit in their absolute and un controlled discretion . The Trustees shall have power, if any deed it in their absolute discretion to sell the Trust Fund or any part thereof and any such immovable property purchased by them under the power aforesaid and any other shares, securities, etc. and stand possessed of the money to arise from such sale upon after paying there out the expenses pertaining to such sale upon the Trusts and with the subject to powers and provision including and all the posers contained by and under these presents declared and contained concerning the Trust Fund which or the proceeds thereof, shall have laid out in purchase of property or properties as have laid out in purchase of property or properties as aforesaid or such of them as

9. That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust , the Trustees shall have the following powers :

- (i) To accept any donation , contribution, Loan Grant or subscription in cash or in kind , from any person (S) or association of person (S) or body corporate or Trust with or without conditions .
- (ii) To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust , or the Trust fund or accumulations there to , any one or more or the objects of the trust, as the trustees may , in their discretion , deem fit from time to time.
- (iii) To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
- (iv) To open account in the name of the Trust, with a bank or banks to operate such account and to give instructions to the Bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of the Trustees or by an agent appointed by the Trustees. But the signature of the settler —cum —trustee is compulsory
- (v) To adjust, settle, compromise, compound refers to arbitration, all actions. Suits claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust fund.
- (vi) To engage or make provision for the engagement of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or settler -cum trustees or otherwise) for the

purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may prescribe and also to engage or provide for the engagement.

- (vii) To make very alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs there of and /or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- (viii) To start, abolish, discontinuations and restart any charity of charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- (ix) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or the part there of for any of the objects of the Trust.
- (x) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this Trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects, upon such terms and conditions as the Trustees may in their discretion think fit ,particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this Trust.
- (xi) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or otherwise ,to different charitable institutions , societies, organisations or Trust in India which may have been established or which may hereinafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organisation or Trustees to start maintain, or carry out such charitable objects.
- (xii) To settle all accounts and to compromise, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim, demand or things, as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- (xiii) To borrow money either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents, and it shall be lawful for the Trustee to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and conditions as they may in their absolute discretion think fit.
- (xiv) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscriptions, affiliation and other assistance including lease and substance of property with a view to promote the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government

- (xv) To take over or amalgamate with any other Charitable Public Trust, Trust, association, or institution with similar objects.
- (xvi) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- (xvii) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- (xviii) To take land/property on lease and then after sublease the land/property to the farmers and other organizations like cooperative/society/urban public bodies/gram panchayat or any being thereof in rural area/local municipal/district and other bodies corporation/company for farming/agriculture/plantation purposes.
- 10. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such money, and funds, which will actually come into their hands.
- 11. The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustee may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
- 12. The Settler-cum- Trustee for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustee within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and reappointment as the trustees for the time being consider proper.
- 13. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either:
- •If he without leave of absence does not attend three consecutive meeting of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer, or
- •If he is requested to resign by 2/3rd or as near thereto as possible of the remaining trustees.
- •In the absence of Settler-cum- Trustee, the Trustee of the Trust's will take charge and function of Settler-cum-Trustee.
- 14 Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of trustees. In the absence of such regulations:

- (a) Two Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees.
- (b) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustee.
- (c) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of two thirds of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- 15. The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any money or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoing ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorise the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorised by these presents.
- 16. The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year.
- 17. The Trust and the Trust funds shall be irrevocable for all the times.
- 18. It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.
- 19. Working areas of the trust will be all over India and all other countries.
- 20. Two-thirds majority shall constitute the office of the Trust at Patna unless changed by the Trustees.
- POWER & FUNCTION OF THE OFFICE BEARER

SETTLER-CUM- TRUSTEE:

The Settler-cum- Trustee shall preside at all meetings of the trust, when he is present and shall exercise such other powers as are conferred upon him by these rules. The Settler-cum- Trustee may call for an emergency meeting through Settler-cum- Trustee Signed notice in a shorter period. The decision of Settler-cum- Trustee that a resolution has been carried or lost shall be conclusive, unless such a decision is challenged and a poll is demanded, on poll being demanded, the same shall be taken in such manner as the Settler-

cum- Trustee may in discretion determine. In case of a tie the Settler-cum- Trustee shall have a second or casting vote.

- a) She/He shall be in charge of the office and shall be responsible to general body in all matters. He will contract in all ways and means of the position of the association and shall have right to improve it.
- b) She/He shall be convener of all the meetings and without his signature on the notice of meetings no meetings will be valid.
- c) She/It shall be his duty to see that the resolution at the respective meeting are implemented and give to effect to timely.
